

Hi Derek,

I would like to see the landfill protocol address not only methane combustion, but also emphasize the need to reduce input into landfills.

As a signatory to the United Nations Urban Environmental Accords, Sacramento is attempting to achieve 2 actions that are key to meeting greenhouse gas reduction goals set by the Governor in his Executive Order and under AB32, These are:

#4 MAXIMIZING landfill diversion (e.g. Zero Waste)

#6 MINIMIZING input to landfills (e.g. reduce, reuse, recycle)

Beyond minimizing input into landfills, input into the waste stream needs to be minimized; the state should consider some type of cap on per capita generation and extended producer responsibility so that the onus is not fully placed on local jurisdictions.
