



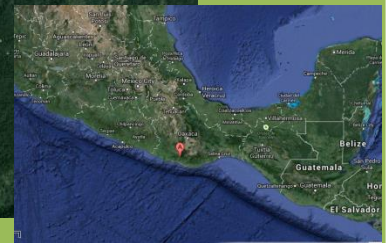
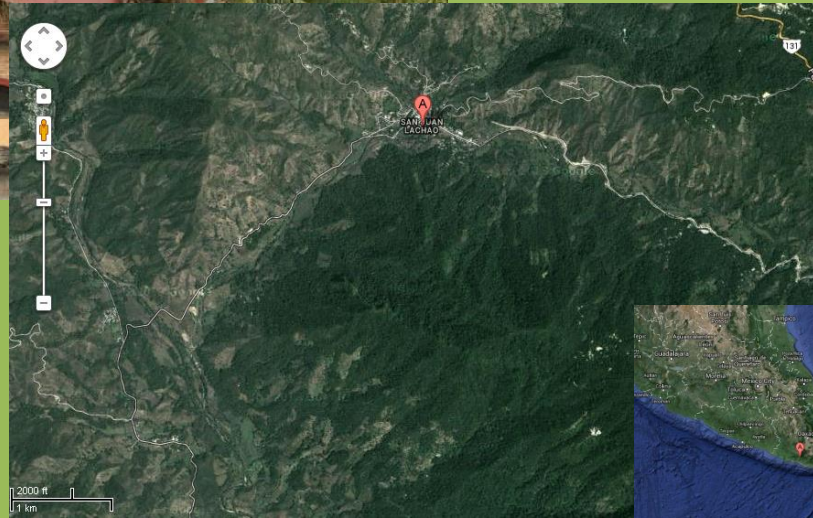
San Juan Lachao
