## Goals of Jurisdiction Subcommittee

## Identify finite solutions to the following

- 1. Build the justification for the nested project approach in Mexico
- 2. Demonstrate the carbon accounting mechanics of nested projects to jurisdictions

## Identify options to the following to be shared with jurisdictions

- 1. Methods for calculating sharing of benefits between projects and jurisdictions based on merits of accounting.
- 2. Methods for accounting for leakage at jurisdiction level and how jurisdiction-level estimates can inform project-level accounting.
- 3. Accounting and enforcement mechanisms for ensuring permanence such that risks and liabilities may be shared between projects and jurisdictions.
- 4. Measurement, monitoring and verification systems and methods that could be deployed at varying spatial scales and allow for true-up between project- and jurisdiction-level quantification.

Review and provide technical feedback to policy options raised by jurisidictions (California/partner jurisdiction) related to:

- 1. Crediting baselines
- 2. Methods of determining reference levels
- 3. Crediting pathways? (Or more precisely perhaps, interactions between project-level activities and jurisdiction policies and measures designed to reduce deforestation)
- 4. Governance structures?
- 5. Social accountability?
